Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for all of your support this term, attending parents' evenings, inspire workshops, supporting our trips and visits and supporting your children with reading and homework.

PE Kit

Could you please ensure that your child/children have a PE kit that is left in school. It is really important that children have the correct PE kit with trainers/pumps in school as if they are chosen



to represent the school at a sports competition, they must be in the correct school PE kit. We do not ask for expensive kits with logo's, but all children must have plain black shorts



and a plain white t-shirt without any name or

logo. This must be in a drawstring PE bag and consist of:

Black shorts/leggings/joggers Plain white t-shirt

Plain black hoody/zip up hooded top

Black pumps or trainers (these must be in the PE bag and not the footwear that your child has worn to school) Black plimsolls are recommended for EYFS and KS1.

Some PE lessons do take place outside so it is advisable that your child has joggers/leggings and a hooded top in their PE bag during the colder months. PE kits will be kept in lockers in KS2.

Car Park

Do not walk across the car park – please stay on the paths. There are still a lot of parents cutting across the car park at the moment between the cars. Please also be responsible when parking near the school, do not park on the yellow lines or in front of driveways.





Thank you to all the parents who have supported our trips, the children have really enjoyed these experiences. In future, the collection of children after any trip, regardless of the time we return or if we are running late, will be from

inside the school, either the classroom door or the hall door, depending on the time. No child will be allowed to be collected from the coach. This is for the safety of all children.

Trips and workshops will continue in the Summer terms including the residential to Ingestre Hall which takes place in April. We have now made provisional bookings for the residential trips for 2024/2025 to Edgmond Hall and Ingestre Hall. Please be aware that if we do not receive sufficient payments the trips will be unable to go ahead. Please see the list of planned dates.

The school football team have taken part in matches against other Sandwell schools this half term, the matches will continue next term. The children are very enthusiastic and are taking their place on the team seriously.




Science Fayre
