Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) spending plan 2014-2015

Total allocated: £139,100

- Part funding of an additional LSP in Reception for the first half term to enable children to settle in more quickly and for language development to be supported.
- Interventions (including basic skills, speech and language) provided by teaching assistant in the EYFS.
- New library facilities in the EYFS and the whole school. To include new books linked to topics and opportunities for parents and carers to select books with their children.
- Part funding of family support worker to support vulnerable children and tackle concerns including attendance.
- Part funding of HLTA to work with vulnerable pupils who need mentoring or support with emotional and behavioral difficulties.
- Additional learning support practitioner to work in EYFS and year 1 to focus on language acquisition and development. Spring term onwards.
- Additional part time teacher to work in year 6, to improve progress and attainment in reading, writing and mathematics. Through provision of sets and small group focused activities. Spring term onwards
- Additional in class support in all year groups to accelerate progress in reading, writing and mathematics.
- Small group support from teaching assistants to accelerate progress in reading, writing and mathematics.
- Homework club
- Part funding of booster groups for y2 and y6
- ICT resources to support learning
- Additional books to enhance guided reading and literacy.

- The school will continue with whole staff training on language development and improving progress and attainment in reading.
- Theatre visit for pupils in KS2
- Whole school maths training: *Maths makes sense* Autumn Term
