

Sports Premium Funding 2016-2017

Schools must use the sports premium funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer.

The premium should be used to:

- Develop or add to the PE and sport activities that school already offers.
- Make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years.

Burnt Tree Primary received £8820 of Sports Premium Funding. Our aims are:

- To increase the opportunities for pupils to take part in organised and team sporting activities.
- To encourage pupils to take part in a variety of sports including some new ones.
- To improve the facilities and equipment available at school.

We will use the funding in the following way:

- Purchase of new equipment (including table tennis tables, racquets, nets, balls and gymnastics equipment)
- Playground markings for specific games including netball and football.
- Sports coaches to deliver a wide range of after school clubs including football, archery, table tennis, cricket, rugby, multi sports, gymnastics.
- Sports coaches to provide gymnastics sessions for talented pupils.
- Play leader to organise games at lunchtime.
- A new kit for team events and tournaments
- Part funding of HLTA to organise outdoor games at lunchtime
- Qualified sports coaches to support our staff to deliver high quality PE lessons with a focus on gymnastics and games.
