## Social distancing and masks



Can we please recommend that all parents wear a mask when entering the school grounds. Adults may be asked to remove their mask when collecting a child if a staff member is unsure of your identity. Please be considerate of other people and adhere to social distancing

when you are on the school premises. Do not congregate on the playground or outside the gates. **Only 1 adult is supposed to be bringing and collecting each family. Some families have not been adhering to the rules. Any additional adults must wait outside of the school grounds.**

As soon as we know, we will let you know the arrangements. Remote learning and workpacks will continue after half term.
